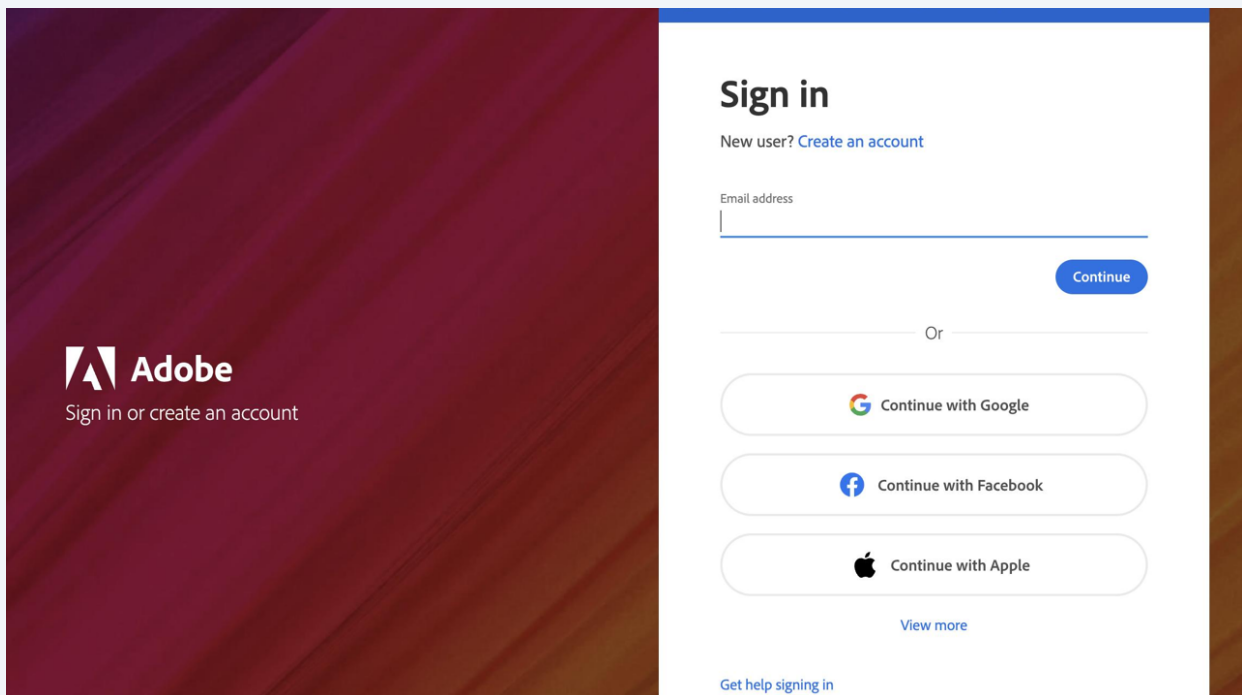

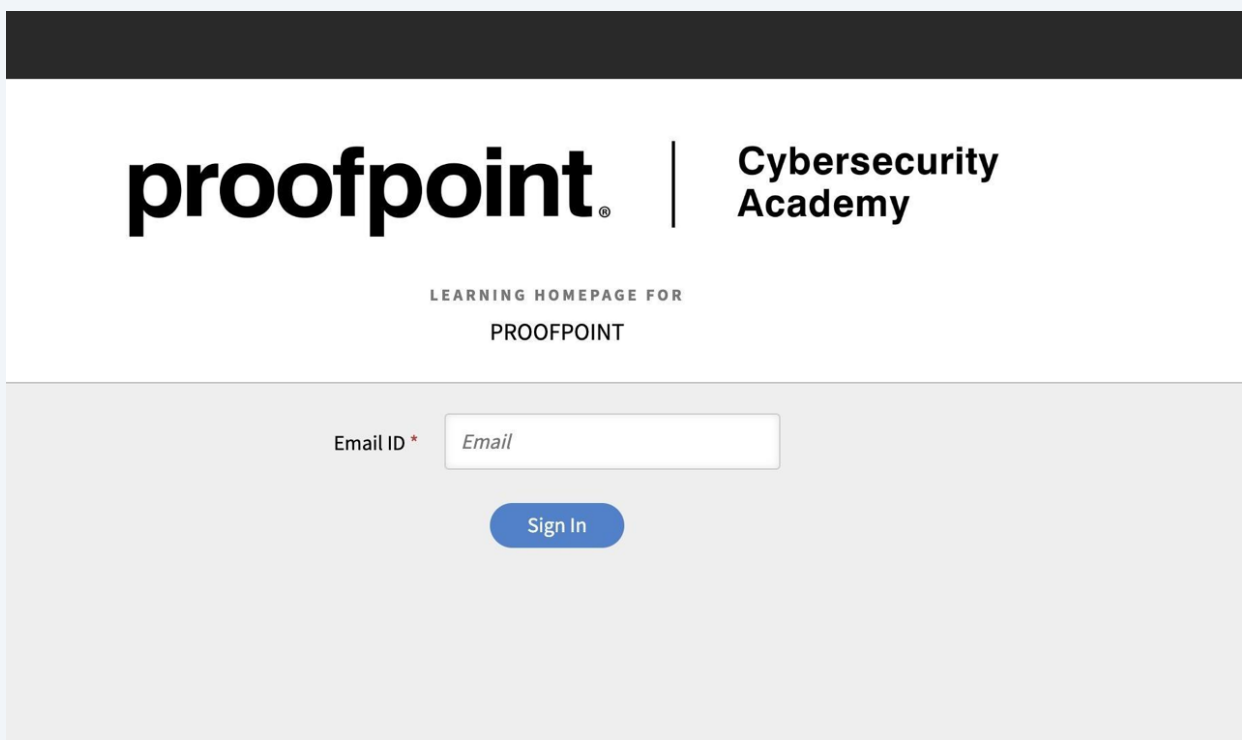

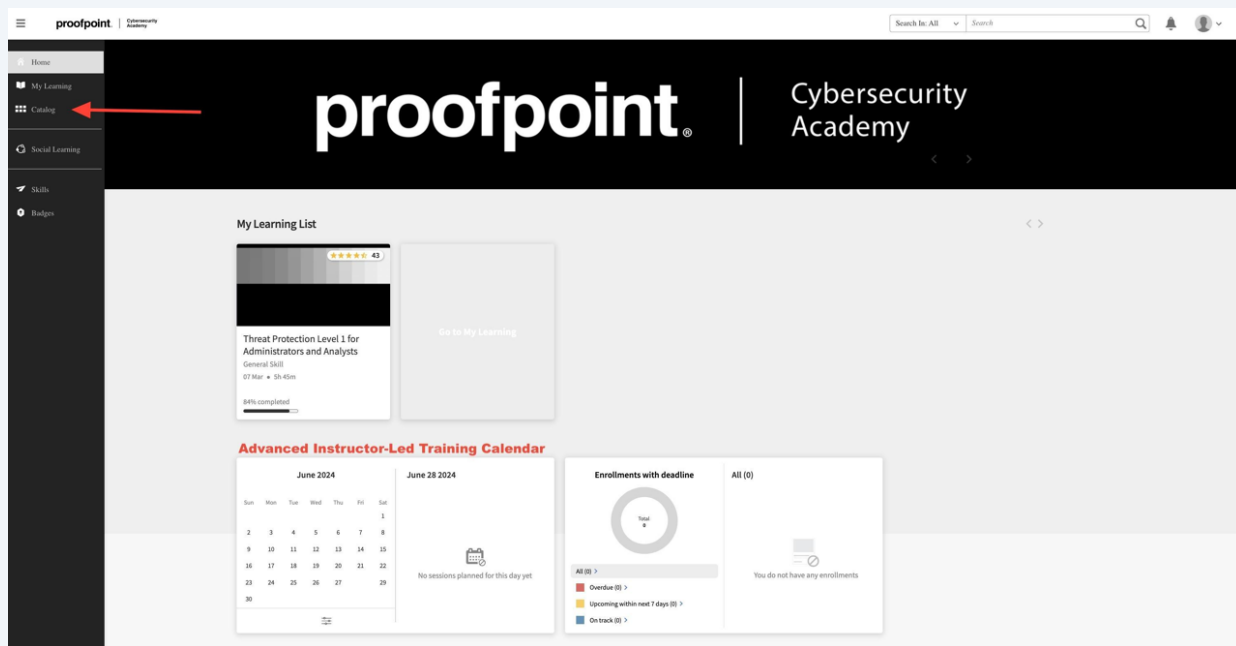
How to Enroll Into Training


You may self-enroll into the web-based trainings we offer by browsing through our course catalog.

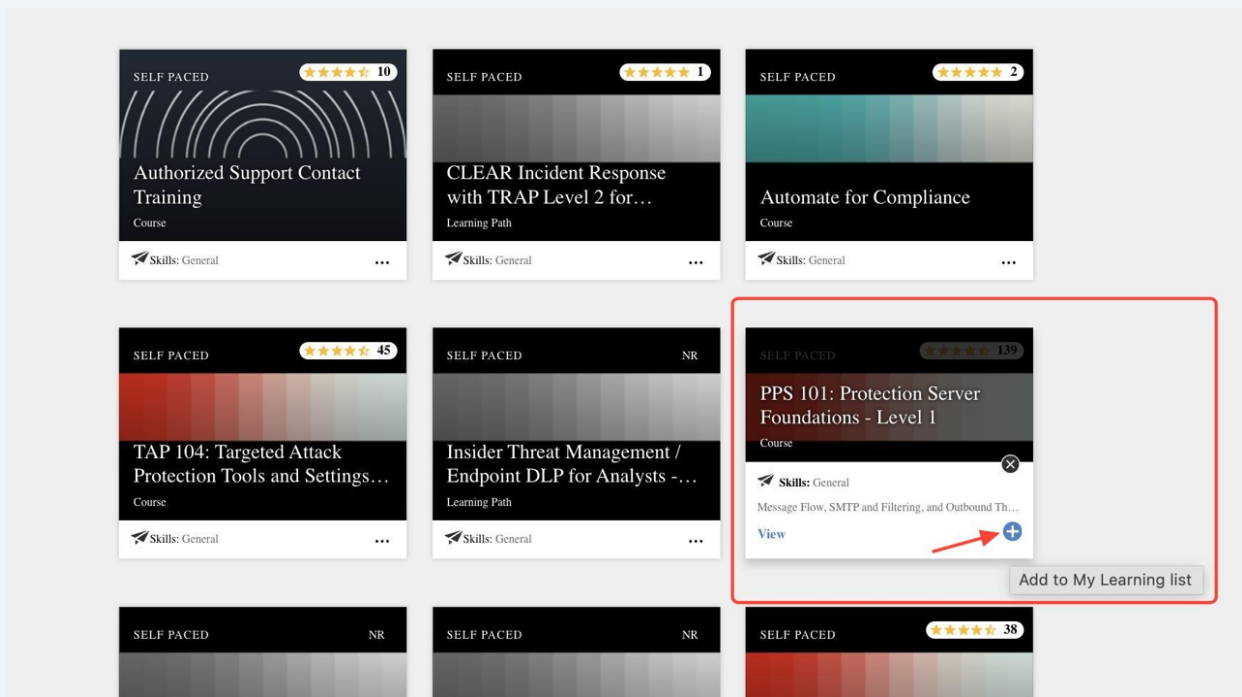
